- Government organizations (city, county, state, federal and active US military) are exempt from fees. This exemption does not apply to elected officials.
- ALL entries (except Town of Matthews Commissioners) must provide own parade transportation and must list vehicle description(s) on application.
- Accepted entries will receive a map and instructions 1-2 weeks prior to parade.
 The parade starts promptly at 9:30am on August 31st, rain or shine; entries are to be in assigned staging location by 8:30am.
- Matthews Alive Board of Directors reserves the right to exclude any parade entry for any reason.

II. Deadlines:

- For **rented floats** from Festival, the float applications and fees must be received by **July 17** to be eligible to participate in the parade.
- All other applications and fees must be received by August 15th

III. Parade Rules and Regulations:

- Groups, riding or walking, must have a designated adult (over 21 years of age) with them at all times during the parade; Adult will be responsible for the conduct and safety of all groups.
- Drivers must be 21 years of age or older and have a current driver's license. Please follow direction
 and pace set by parade staff and police representatives. Float drivers must have towing experience,
 adequate view of any float, and effective communication to float riders and any walkers or spotters.
- No candy or other items are to be thrown from parade entries, however, walkers beside the entry will be allowed to safely hand candy or other items to the crowd (no bottled or canned drinks, please).
- For the safety of participants, attendees, and spectators, the noise level from any parade entry cannot exceed 85 decibels (no loud sirens, horns, music, etc.).
- Entries cannot exceed 17-feet in height.
 - Horse/animal entries are required to clean up after themselves (manure bags are strongly recommended). All animals must be in good health and be able to cope with crowds, other animals, and a somewhat chaotic environment.
- No motorized vehicles, smoking, alcoholic beverages, or glass containers are allowed on floats. Riders must remain on the float throughout the route, keeping arms and legs above the sides of the flatbed.
- Matthews Alive is not responsible for items left on floats or along the parade route.

IV. Insurance Requirements:

 All entries should make sure that their participants are covered by their organization's Comprehensive General Liability Insurance policy. If you do not have liability insurance, your insurance company can advise you on securing "Event Insurance" to cover your participation in the parade. All parade entries must sign the liability clause in this application in order to participate. Matthews Alive, Inc. may require evidence of insurance coverage of up to \$1,000,000 in order for entries to participate.

V. Commentator/Branding Information:

- Promote your group or business while having a lot of fun! Use professional signage in front of your entry, on the flatbed of your float, on the back wall of your float, or on the side of your vehicle. The name of any float entry/purchaser will be on the sides of each rented float that is provided by the Festival.
- To help promote our parade entries, we will be providing an emcee and PA system with speakers in the heart of the route. Please write a short narrative about your entry as you would like it read by the emcee (35 words or less). ALL ENTRIES MUST PROVIDE A NARRATIVE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PARADE. If you are a float, make sure we have narratives about your group/company, as well as any riding group that is different from you. Please send these narratives in with your application by August 15th—The Parade Director will prepare printed cards with the narratives for the emcee ahead of time!

The Committee reserves the right to edit and approve these narratives for time and content, and cannot guarantee exact verbiage.
